MEXICO TO CANADA TRAIL RIDERS HELP TO REACH THE 100,000 MILE MARK

The Mexico to Canada Trail Riders riding with the *Best of America by Horseback* television show, seen weekly on the nationally broadcast RFD-TV network, will reach the 100,000 mile mark for the cumulative trail miles ridden by horseback riders riding with *Best of America by Horseback* since the show began in 2005. This milestone is expected to be reached on or near May 20, 2009. The riders participating in the Mexico to Canada Trail Ride from 24 states began the ride on April 21, 2009 at the US/Mexico border will be having a rest over in Moriarty, NM throughout this weekend.

The group has already been recognized by over 20 Governors from various states as well as recognized by Rick Potts, Chief of the Conservation and Outdoor Recreation Division of the National Park Service and escorted in part by Dave Simon, Director of the NM State Park System. In addition, the riders have been recognized by several community parades, presentations and activities throughout during these first weeks of the ride. They have also been invited to lead the annual Pioneer Day's parade in the Custer, South Dakota this July. The group has already completed the famous Jornada del Muerto, "Journey of Death" trail through the White Sands Desert, where the group rode through adverse conditions, camped out under the stars each night and completed the desolate stretch without incident, accident or injury.

Best of America by Horseback's Mexico to Canada Trail Ride is being led by Thomas A. Seay, Outdoorsman of Culpeper, VA and assisted by Trail Masters, Hayward Simmons of Fairfax, SC and Del Shields of Humboldt, KS. Camera crews are following the activities and experiences of this horseback adventure. Horsemen from across the country are joining the core riders, who are making the entire 4 ½ month, 1800 mile trail ride, for a week or two at a time, to be a part of and share in this once in a lifetime experience. Tom Seay, said "Horseback riders from across the country are truly welcomed to join us and I invite them to do so."
